





Bharati Vidyapeeth is now a leading educational institution in the country, which has created a history by establishing within a short span of 50 years or so 190 educational institutions imparting education from the pre-primary stage to post graduate stage. Our colleges and institutions of higher education impart education in different disciplines including Medicine, Dentistry, Ayurved, Homoeopathy, Nursing, Arts, Science, Commerce, Engineering, Pharmacy, Management, Social Sciences, Law, Environmental Science, Architecture, Hotel Management and Catering Technology, Physical Education, Computer Science, Library Science, Information Technology, Biotechnology & Agriculture.

Besides these 190 educational institutions, Bharati Vidyapeeth has also been successfully running a Co-operative Bank, Co-operative Consumer Stores, a Co-operative Poultry, a Co-operative Sugar Factory, Charitable Hospitals and Medical Research Centre and the like.

Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed Univesity. Pune

As mentioned earlier, the Department of Human Resource Development, Government of India on the recommendation of University Grants Commission accorded the status of Deemed University to twelve units of Bharati Vidyapeeth (vide their notification No. F.9-15/95-U.3 dated 26/4/96 under the Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act. of 1956).

Subsequently, the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the UGC and AICTE brought three more institutions of Bharati Vidyapeeth within the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth University vide their letter No. F9-15/95-U3 dated 28th July, 2000. The University Grants Commission vide their Letter No. F.No. 3-2/90 CPP-1 dated 17th August 2002, have agreed to bring two more research institutions within the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth University. During the current year, a Medical College at Sangli and a Dental College at Navi Mumbai have also been brought within the ambit of this Deemed University by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India vide its notification dt. 19th August, 2004. In Feb. 2005 once again Govt. of India vide notification No. F9-16/2004U3 dated 25th Feb. 2005 brought following seven Institutes under the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth University.



Admission Rules:

 a) i. Admission can be sought only on the parent's submitting an application in the prescribed form available in the school office.

- ii. The parents or an authentic guardian will have to accompany the child seeking admission.
- b) A candidate who desires to join the school fresh from home after completing pre-primary or from a private school must produce an official proof of the date and place of birth, such as Municipal or Baptismal Certificate or an Affidavit made before a stipendiary magistrate.
- c) Boys and girls who have completed the age of 6 on or before 31st July of the pertaining year can only be admitted to the Std I
- d) A student coming from a recognized school, can be admitted only on producing a Leaving Certificate from that school; if the pupil comes from outside the State of Maharashtra, the Leaving Certificate must be duly countersigned by the competent Educational authority of the State concerned.
- No admission for Std I is complete until a proper Birth / Leaving Certificate is handed over to the school authority.



School Fees:

School fees must be paid term wise in June & December of every year.

Withdrawals: a) A notice of withdrawals must be given by filling in the form of application for the Leaving Certificate available in the school calendar at least three days before the end of the month, failing which the fees of the following manths will be charged. Such notice must be given by the person authentically responsible for the pupil and not by the pupil himself/herself.

b) If no notice of withdrawal is given, full fees for all the months of absence will be charged along with D.P.C. If the name of the pupil is on the roll even for one day of the month, the fee for the entire month will be charged.

Std V to X:-

Boys: Dark Blue striped White shirt with school badge, Dark Blue short pant (Full pant for Std VIII to X), belt & tie.

Girls: Blue striped white shirt, Dark Blue pinafore with school badge (Divided skirt for Std VIII to X), belt & tie.

Socks: Navy blue

Shoes: Black

House T-shirt, Navy Blue track pant and sports shoes on Wednesday.

Scout & Guide uniform on Thursday.

Navy Blue sweater for winter season is compulsory for all students.

Every student must have these sets of uniform. There should be no difference in the colour shades of pink and blue.

Please Note:

- The school uniform must be worn every day except on birthday.
- On birthday the students should wear a dress suitable for school atmosphere. They should not wear real (gold) ornaments.

Boys should trim their hair regularly. Girls having long hair should tie two plaits. Uniform should be well ironed and shoes ought to be well polished.

Curricular:

Student-centered teaching learning experiences are emphasized by our well- qualified and experienced teaching staff enabling the students to excel in academics. Assessment of academic achievements is carried out in the following manner:

Std I to VIII:-

- a) The school will conduct two Practice Tests, two Unit Tests and Two Semester Examinations. Baseline or any other tests according to the instructions received from the Education Department will be conducted.
- Other regular evaluations such as orals assignments, projects / activities, etc. as mentioned in the CCE pattern will be conducted from time to time.

Std IX:- Two Unit Tests and two Semester Exams will be conducted.

Std X:- Two Unit tests, one Semester Exam and two Prelim Exams will be conducted.

Besides, our students also appear for the Bharati Talent Search Examination, Olympiad, Pre Upper Primary & Pre Secondary Scholarship Examination, NTS Examination and come out with flying colours.

Library:

The students from Std III onwards will get library books once a week enabling the student to develop an affinity towards extensive reading habits and for additional academic references. All students are expected to keep a record of the library books read by them every week.



Extra-Curricular:

A wide range of extra curricular activities such as elocution competition, fancy dress, solo dance, annual sports, annual day, celebrations of festivals, birth anniversaries, observing death anniversaries, quiz competition, science & art / craft exhibition, etc. supplementing the curricular and giving exposure to the hidden talents of our students are organized every year.

General Rules of Conduct:

- A student must strictly adhere to all the rules mentioned in this Prospectus and as and when notified by the school authorities.
- Students must be punctual and regular in attendance.
 - No student should remain absent for any reason other than sickness, without obtaining prior permission of the headmaster.
 - b) Absence due to sickness will have to be supported by a written application by the parent/ guardian along with a proper medical certificate as early as possible. A student having a contagious and infectious disease will not be allowed to attend the school unless a proper medical certificate is submitted.
- No student will be allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours (even during recess) without the permission of the headmaster.
- The students are advised not to bring any valuable articles to the school. The school authorities do not

- stand responsible for the loss of the student's cycle, books, money and other articles.
- The students are expected to handle the school property carefully. Any damage to any school property will be recovered from the responsible ones.
- To acquire greater fluency in the study of English the students are advised to speak in English even in their private conversation within the school premises.
- Any student who is persistently insubordinate or repeatedly guilty of malpractice / serious indiscipline may be expelled from the school.
- A student is not allowed to enter any classroom other than his / her own.
- A student is liable for punishment for indiscipline in the school as well as outside the school.
- A student must keep up the prestige and tradition of the school.
- 11. A student must not take part in any political activity.
- 12. Library: The student must use the library book very carefully. No page should be torn. Strictly nothing must be written on the books. The students have to pay the recovery if the book is damaged.

Guidelines to Parents:

 Parents are requested to be co-operative with the school authorities by enforcing regularity, punctuality and discipline.

- Parents should encourage their children to take active part in school activities.
- Parents must join hands with the school and make efforts for the all-round development of the child.
- 4. Parents should inform the school authorities and the concerned teachers as well if the ward is suffering from any serious illness. Medical Check –Up: The medical checkup of every student will be done in the school. Parents should go through the Doctor's report and do the needful.
- 5. Parents must go through the calendar daily and help their child to follow the instructions given by the teacher. While the authorities and teachers will exercise supervision over the classwork, it shall be the responsibility of the parents / guardians to see that the pupil has done the homework assigned to him / her. If the parents have any difficulty regarding the studies of the ward they can bring it to notice of the school authorities without any hesitation.
- If a pupil has misplaced the calendar, the parents will
 please see to it that the calendar is replaced, and the
 class teacher is informed accordingly.
- Any parent who wants to see the ward in the school should ask for the prior permission of the headmaster.
- Parents should not meet any teaching staff during the school hours except during emergency with the permission of the concerned authority.

 The parents / guardians should address all correspondence in respect of their ward to the headmaster only.

Role of the Parents:

- Respect the personality of the child.
- Aim always to realize how things look and fit from the child's point of view.
- Stimulate and reward his curiosity by always answering patiently and fairly.
- Give him opportunity to do things and make things for himself.
- Be a playmate and giver of joy.

- Impart a friendly attitude towards people.
- Be an example of that which you would have your child to become.


